



## Nashville Superspeedway Track Lap Day – Corvette Caravan 30<sup>th</sup> Anniversary

In celebration of the National Corvette Museums 30 Year Anniversary, Nashville Superspeedway is offering each chapter the exciting opportunity to drive their personal vehicle around Nashville's fastest D-shaped oval. Drivers will experience the same 1.3-mile racing surface, 14-degree banking in the turns, 9 degrees on the front straightaway and 6 degrees in the back straightaway that NASCAR and Indy Car drivers face during races at the Nashville Superspeedway.



### Track Lap Event Details

- 4-hour window for track laps – August 28, 2024
- Ability for designated Corvette Vehicle to pace the field for each lap session.
- Customized registration page and creative designs to share with chapters
- Accesses to paddock for staging and parking
- Drive through Victory Lane for photo opportunity prior to track laps – must provide photographer
- Max Speed 75 MPH - Laps led by Official Track Pace Car in groups of 10 – 15 vehicles
- Exclusive ticket offers for 2024 NASCAR race weekend

### Costs

- 5-Laps ~~\$145~~ \$100 per vehicle
  - Includes Fire and Medical costs
- Minimum 200 cars

### Liability Requirements

- Standard Track Policy Coverage \*
- Ability to purchase required insurance coverage from track for \$1,500

### Upgrades – can be factored into price of admission based on expected attendance

- Use of 75-Person Presidential Suite - \$3,000
- Use of Garages - \$2,000
- Use of Media Center \$1,500
- Victory Lane Photographer - \$1,000
- Customized Victory Lane Photo Backdrop - \$1,500
- Food & Beverage Options Available

\*A. Lessee, at its sole cost and expense, shall obtain and keep in force during the term of this Agreement the following minimum amounts of insurance coverage that shall be primary and non-contributory with any coverage of Company: (1) Commercial General Liability insurance written on an occurrence basis with limits not less than \$1,000,000 combined single limit per occurrence for bodily injury and property damage; \$2,000,000 general aggregate; \$2,000,000 products-completed operations aggregate; including coverage for participant legal liability, premises-operations, products-completed operations, personal and advertising injury, and contractual liability; (2) Automobile Liability insurance with limits not less than \$1,000,000 combined single limit each accident for bodily injury and property damage, including coverage for all owned, hired and non-owned automobiles; (3) Workers' Compensation insurance with statutory limits; (4) Employer's Liability insurance with limits not less than \$500,000 each accident for bodily injury by accident; \$500,000 each employee for bodily injury by disease; \$500,000 policy limit for bodily injury by disease; and (5) Participant Accident insurance with minimum limits of \$5,000 for death and dismemberment and \$5,000 for medical.
